QUALITY ASSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Material items ordered to Industrial, National or Federal Specifications shall be marked in accordance with the specific marking requirements contained in the specification or referenced within such as ASTM A 700, Standard Practices for Packaging, Marking and Loading Practices for Steel Products for Shipment or ASTM B 666, Identification Marking of Aluminum Products.

ASTM A 700 gives general requirements for packaging, marking and loading of steel products for shipment and may include the following:

- (1) Manufacturer name or brand mark
- (2) Size
- (3) Specification (i.e., A36, A240, AMS 6414)
- (4) Grade (or type for stainless), Alloy (B209, B211)
- (5) Heat or Lot number (not required for C-1018)
- (6) Condition or Temper (A479, A240)

Any material delivered unmarked will be rejected.
